3. Pop/Country: Main and or secondary singer, backing singers, band & dancers
4. Rap: Main rapper, 2 backing rappers and a DJ
5. Opera: Main singer, musicians
6. Classical: Conductor, members of orchestra

Unit01 Task 8- Budgeting a Tour

- As Project Manager you will need to create a Spreadsheet Model that will predict how much they should charge for tickets in order to make £1,000,000 profit.
- In order to make this prediction, the model that we create must be able to process inputs and then output the correct ticket prices.
- Costs for the Tour can be found in Memo 1.



MEMO 1

We have investigated some of the possible costs of the new AC/DC concert, which we would like you to include in your model to let us find out the minimum price that we can sell tickets for in order to make at least **£1,000,000 (or as close as possible to this figure)**. The ticket prices must be the same price over the 3 nights.

Information:

Number of nights the show is performed	3	We think we would like to put the production on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights.
Size of auditorium	20,000	Seats available each night but on Friday 500 seats need to be kept free for VIP's and celebrities.
Security	£10,000	Per night but on Fridays he gets 1.5 times this and on Saturdays he gets double.
Lighting/special effects	£5,000	Per night
Sound System	£15,000	Per night
Rent of Venue	£20,000	Per night

Unit01 Task 8- Budgeting a Tour

- Spreadsheet models enable you to demonstrate: inputs, processes and outputs.
 - **Inputs:** can be the following information:
 - Income - ticket price, number of seats sold
 - Expenditure (costs) - security, lighting, venue rent etc.
 - **Processes:** The calculations the model will need to make
 - Total income = ticket price x number of seats sold - etc.
 - **Outputs**
 - Total income
 - Total costs - Profit/Loss
