Stop!

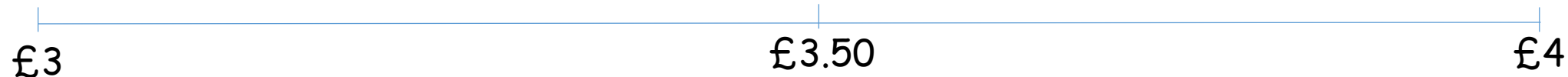
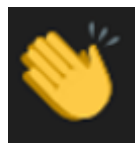
