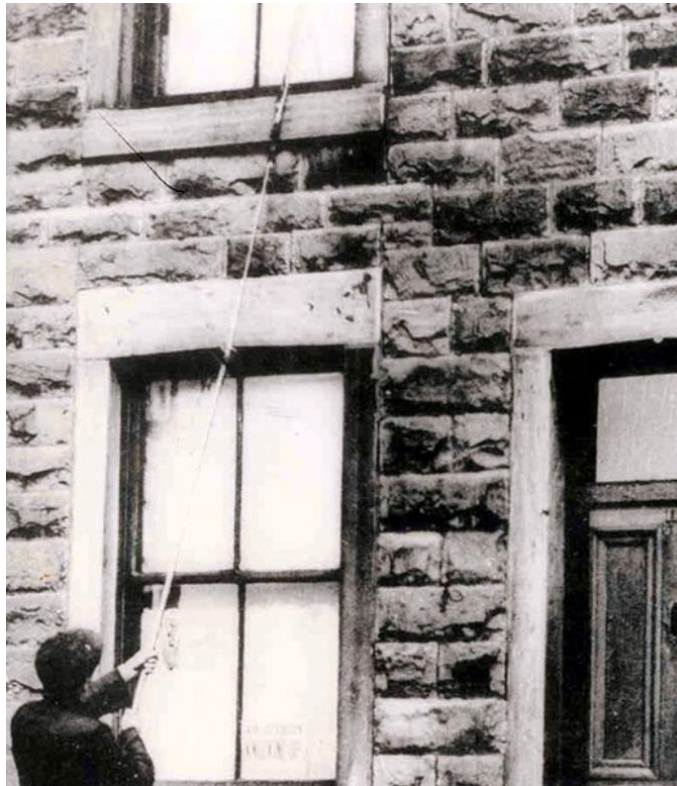

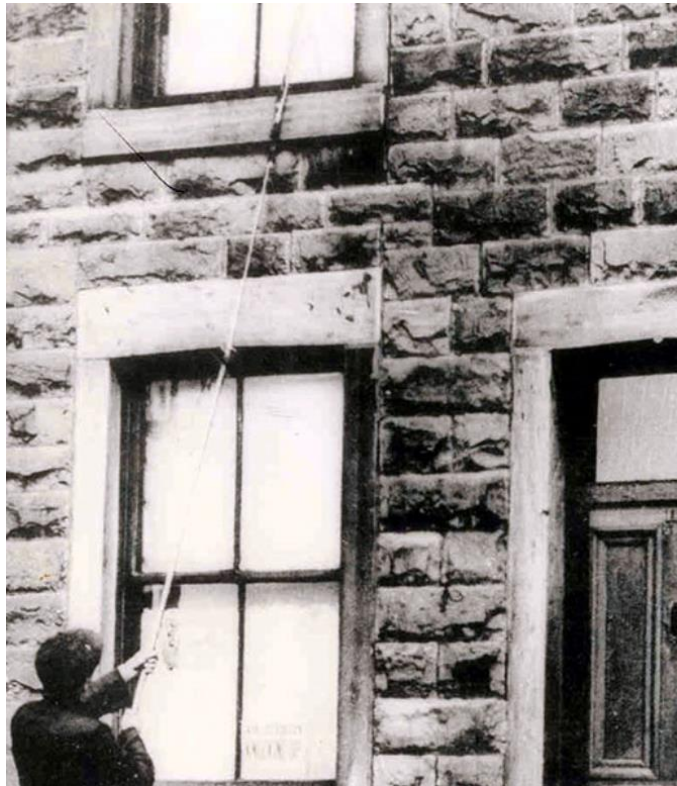

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# Skills and Qualities employers want

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## SUPPORT WORKER

What kind of person we are looking for to do the job (Person Specification)

	They must
<b>Attitude</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be honest</li><li>• Be will to do activities with us (muck in)</li><li>• Dress appropriately</li><li>• Have commonsense</li><li>• Respect us</li><li>• Be confident to challenge on our behalf and be persistent</li><li>• Be sociable</li></ul>
<b>Skills</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be an understanding person</li><li>• Be good at sorting out arguments</li><li>• Be well organized</li><li>• Have good writing skills</li><li>• Have excellent communication and listening skills</li><li>• Have cooking and cleaning skills</li><li>• Have the skills to support us to make our own choices</li></ul>
	<b>It would be good if they ..</b>
<b>Knowledge</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Share some of our interests</li></ul>
<b>Experience</b>	Have had some relevant training including health and safety training.
<b>Skills</b>	Are - <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A driver</li><li>• Good at sewing and weaving</li><li>• Good with money</li><li>• Good at gardening</li></ul>
