


# "Op Art"




Op Art is short for Optical Art.

Bridget Riley is a famous British artist who creates optical art:




# How to create Op Art

Follow the steps and activity to  
create your own Optical Art


## Drawing 1: Steps

1.



Draw some parallel lines across the centre of your page


2.



Next draw vertical lines through the horizontal lines.

Make the lines get closer towards the centre then wider towards the other side


3.



Colour the squares alternately in black


## Drawing 2: Steps

1.




Draw a set of wavy lines across your paper

Draw vertical lines through the horizontal lines

3.



Colour in the alternate squares
