BEST BUY PROBLEMS

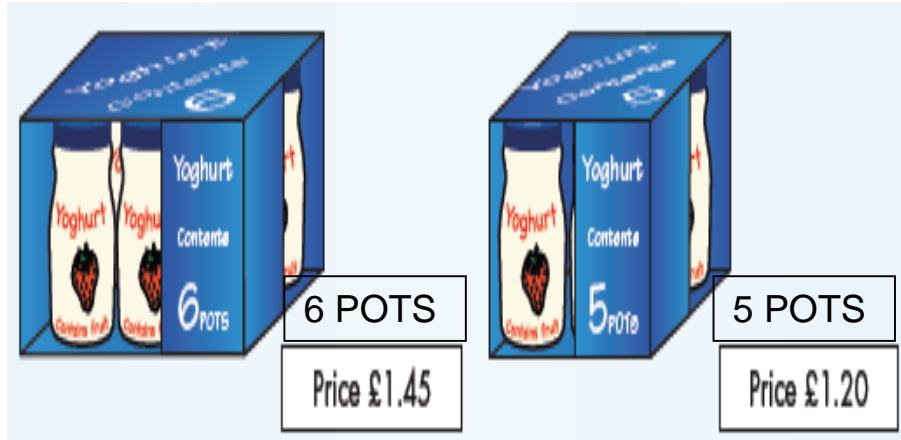
EXAMPLES

(a) A supermarket sells two different-sized packets of Whito soap powder. The medium size contains 800 g and costs £1.60 and the large size contains 2.5 kg and costs £4.75. Which is the better buy?

$$\begin{array}{ccc} \text{MEDIUM} & & \text{LARGE} \\ \div 800 \quad \leftarrow 800\text{g} = \text{£}1.60 \quad \rightarrow \div 800 & \div 2500 \quad \leftarrow 2500\text{g} = \text{£}4.75 \quad \rightarrow \div 2500 & \\ & 1\text{g} = \text{£}0.002 & 1\text{g} = \text{£}0.0019 \end{array}$$

Therefore, the large pack is the better buy.

(b) Which of these boxes is better value?



$$6 \text{ pots} = £1.45$$

$$\boxed{\times 5}$$

$$\boxed{\times 5}$$

$$30 \text{ pots} = £7.25$$

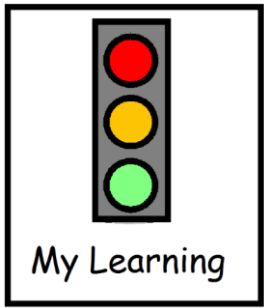
$$5 \text{ pots} = £1.20$$
