

Dinosaurs and Trees

You will need:

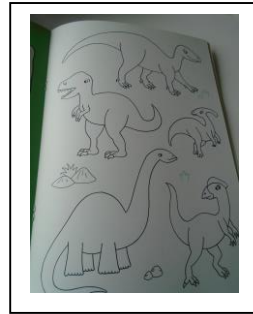
A3 piece of paper

Pencil

Ruler

Pritt stick

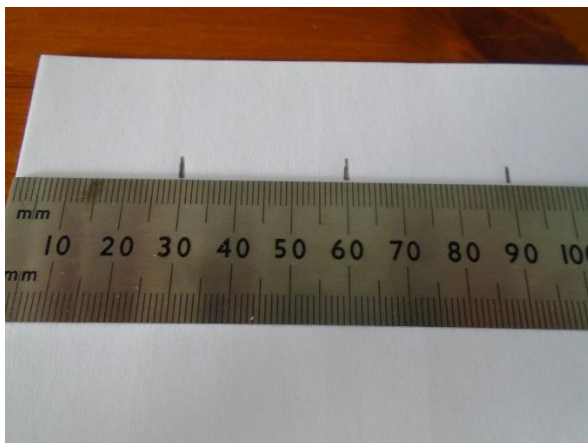
Cut out dinosaurs and trees



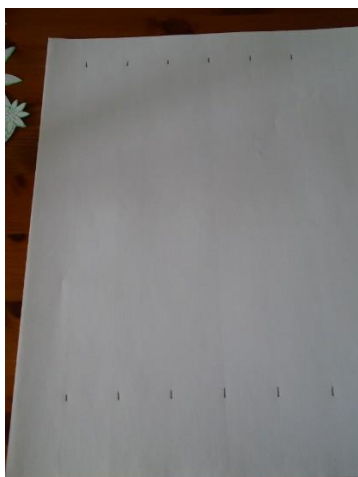
Step 1

Measure across the paper and place a mark every 30mm (3cm)

30,60,90,120,150,180,210,240,270,300



Move the ruler to the bottom of the paper and do the same again.

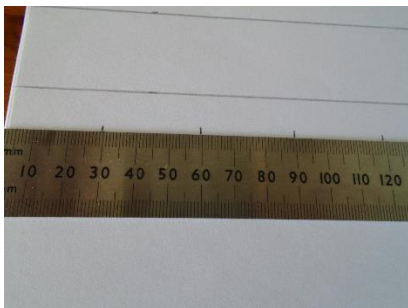


Now turn your ruler around and join up the marks to draw vertical lines



Step 2

Now do the same again by turning your paper around and marking out horizontal lines. Again with 30mm spacing.



Your page should now look like this and have 100 squares



Step 3

Number each square from 1 to 100 (do this in pencil as you might need to move the numbers if they get covered by a dinosaur)

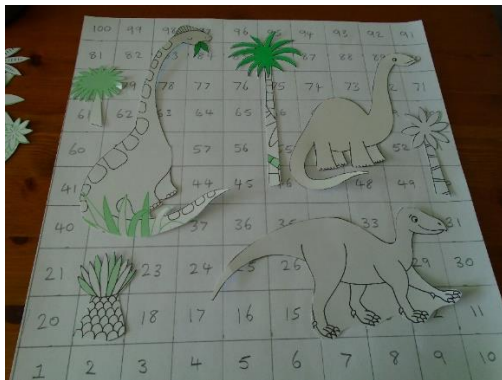
Start from left to right, then when you move onto the next line you need to go from right to left and so on

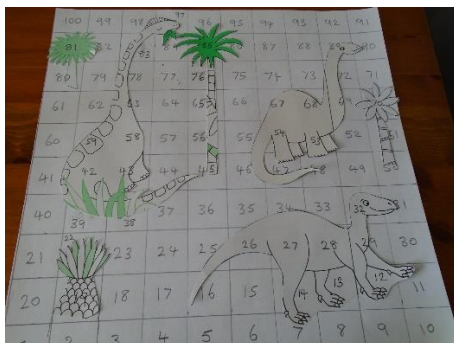
Step 4

Now layout your dinosaurs and trees to plan where they will go



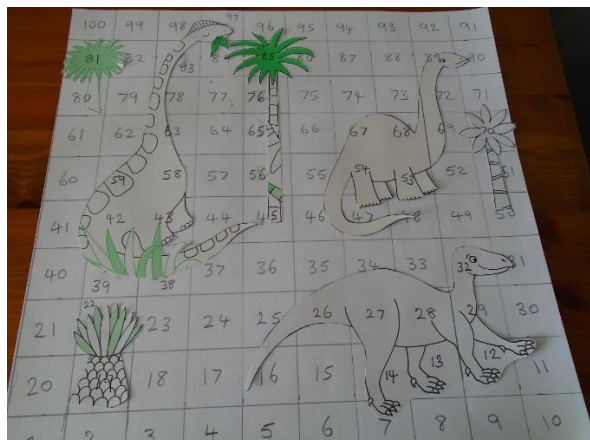
Step 5

Once you are happy with where they are positioned. Stick them down with glue.



Step 6

Write out the numbers again that have been covered up by a dinosaur or tree



Step 7

Colour in your dinosaurs and trees

Go over your numbers with a pen



Step 8

You will need a dice and some counters to play the game.

If you land on a tree you can move up

If you land on a dinosaur, you have to move down (from mouth to the tail)

The first player to get to 100 wins the game.
