

# Year 11 Exam Results and Qualifications 2019-20

Grange Park Students had the opportunity to gain 21 different accreditations across 12 different subject areas in KS4.

The teacher predicted grades submitted by the school took into account mock grades, pupil performance in lessons and prior results from the departments and were

moderated by the Senior Leadership Team. Three grades were moved up by the OFQUAL algorithm.

All Grange Park students gained qualifications in Maths and English and in other areas in line with their interests and ability level.

#### **Destination**

All students were able to access Further Education courses in line with expectations. Ten students moved to Mid-Kent College as Grange Park students and two entered Key Stage 5 at Grange Park School.

Having built on last year's success, more students accessed GCSE subjects and were able to gain passes in a range of subjects.

100% of students gained an accreditation in English Mathematics and Science

83% of students had at least one GCSE pass

60% of students had at least one grade of 4

**60%** of students had four or more GCSE passes

**50%** of students had five or more GCSE passes

# **MATHS**

100% 12(students) gained a mathematics accreditation

100% 7 gained a functional skills qualification in Maths level 1

83% 10 gained a mathematics GCSE

**30%** 3 who took it had a 4+

100% 1 student took and passed GCSE Statistics at grade 4



# **English**

100% 12 students gained an English accreditation

83% 10 students gained an English Language GCSE

30% 2 of students who took it had a 4+

100% 5 students took and passed English Literature GCSE

**40%** 2 students who took it had a 4+, 4 of 5 students had the same grade or better in literature than language

## **SCIENCE**

100% 12 gained accreditations in Science

**100%** 6 students who took GCSE Biology passed it

50% 3 students gained a 4+

100% 2 students who took GCSE Chemistry passed it at grade 4.

100% 6 students that entered gained OCR-ELC in science

83% 5 students gained their ELC at level 2

## **ART AND DESIGN**

100% 8 students who took art GCSE passed it

**75%** 6 students gained a 4+ (three grade 5s)

#### **HOME COOKING**

100% 4 students gained a level 2 qualification

# **SPORTS LEADERS AWARD**

80% 12 students gained a sports leaders award

# **TEXTILES**

100% 4 students who took GCSE textiles achieved a pass

75% 3 students achieved a 4+ grade (two grade 5s)



# **NCFE IT**

100% 7 students achieved a level 1 pass

# **NCFE FLORISTRY**

100% 2 students achieved a level 1 pass
