

JSA Claimant Count





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
Job Trends




Millennials

Racial diversity is high in Gravesham. The national average for an area this size is 16,377 racially diverse people, while there are 21,454 here.










Top Growing Industries








Top Industry GVA









Top Industry Wages

2019 Wages Per Worker












