Placement Information

Work placement is at the Butter Cup Goat Sanctuary. Activities that students undertake support the operations of the organisation. Students take instruction from members of staff regarding clearing out where the goats reside, preparing food, feeding as well as general tasks around the sanctuary. This placement supports student's interest in animal and is a placement that is used for students with a clear interest in animals. The intent of the placement is to offer meaningful tasks related to the industry of interest. When placing students consideration of the students SCERTS, EHC targets, preparing for adulthood pathways and improving the students soft skills

Links to SCERTS

A number of aspects from the SCERT's framework is developed through this work placement. The work placement supports EHC targets for some of the students based around a Transition target linking to career aspirations. Work placement can be linked to C&I, Sensory and Physical target depending on the individual student.
