



Labour Market Information HAIR AND BEAUTY

Around 250,000 people work in the Hair and Beauty sector, over half of which are self-employed. Both Level 2 and 3 apprenticeships are available in a range of roles across the sector. Hair and Beauty salons have higher survival rates than many other sectors after five years. Over the last five years the sector has grown by 45%.

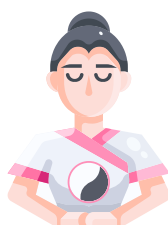

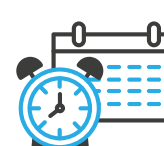
