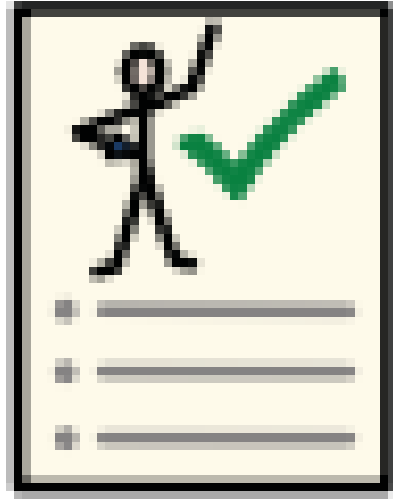

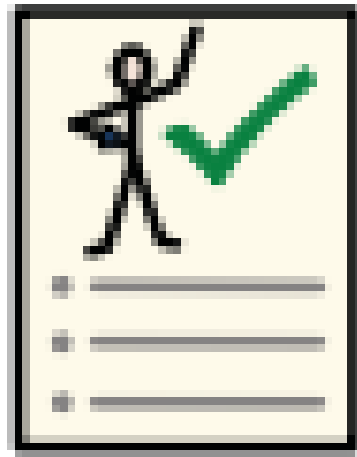

I have the right to follow the customs of my family whether or not these are shared by most of the people in the country where I live.

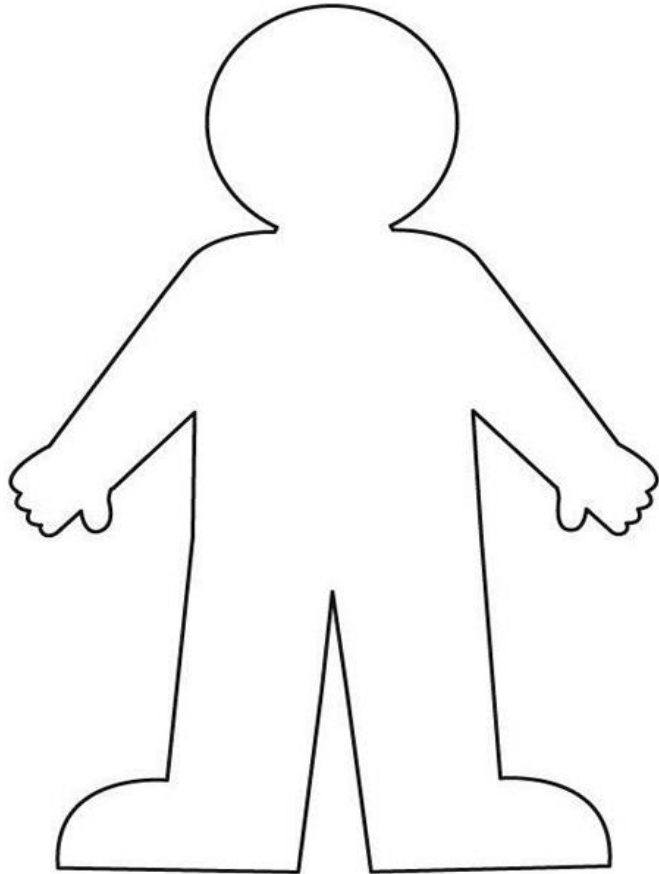


This right and many others are not met
