




The Chinese authorities have banned footballers from getting tattoos and instructed national team players, who already have tattoos, to remove them or cover them up to set a "good example for society". A growing number of Chinese players have tattoos, including the international defender Zhang Linpeng, who has previously been told to cover up while appearing for the national team and his club, Guangzhou FC. The General Administration of Sport of China (GAS) said in a statement about "strengthening the management of football players", the Chinese Football Association would set out disciplinary requirements for national team players.
