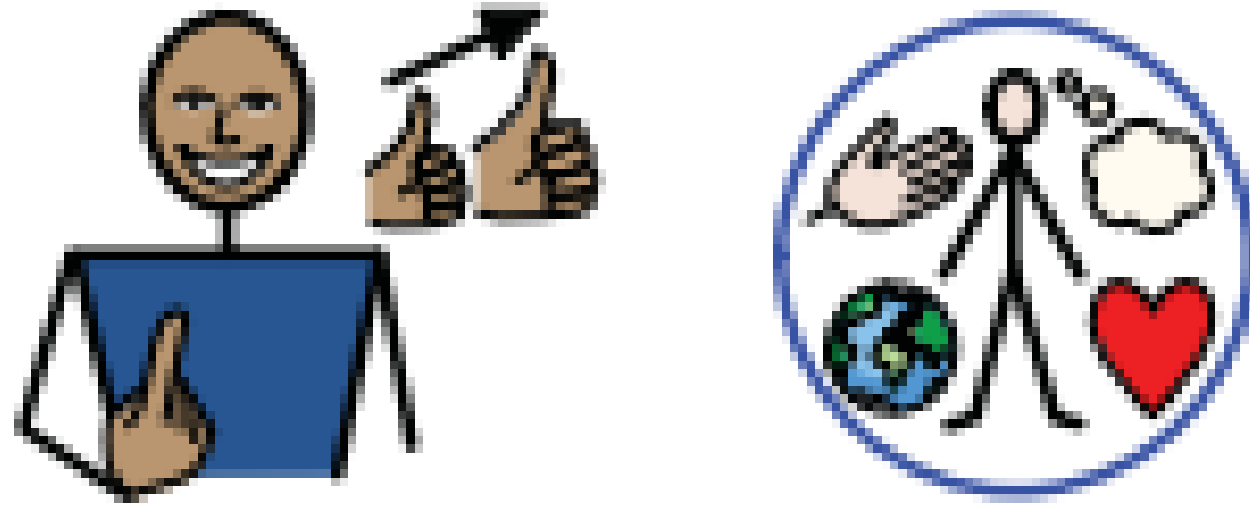
If I have a disability, I have the right to special care and education.
