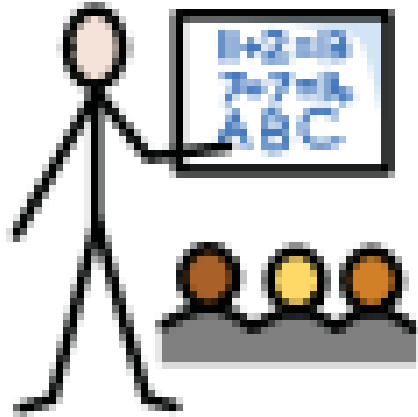


I have a right to a education, which should be free.
