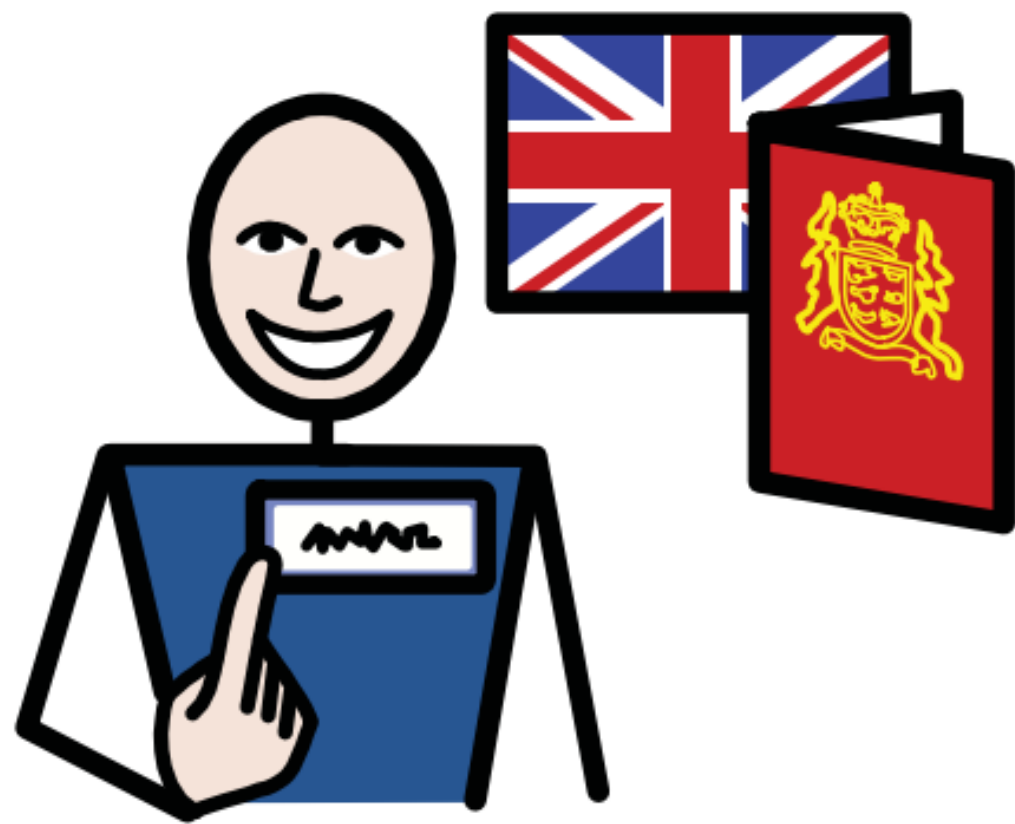


It is Machu Picchu in Peru.

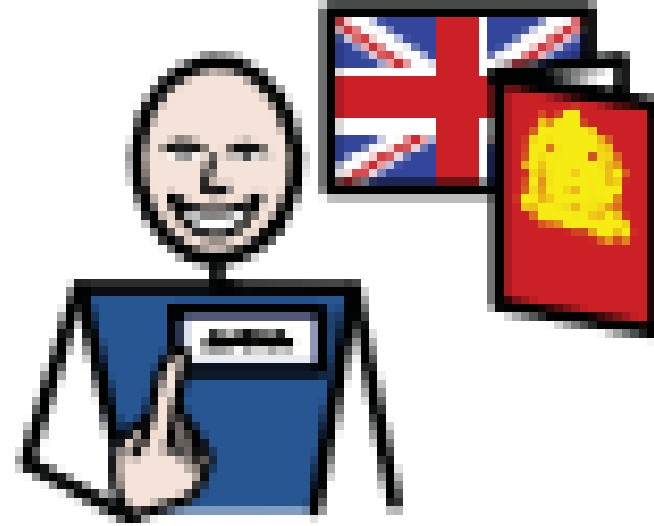
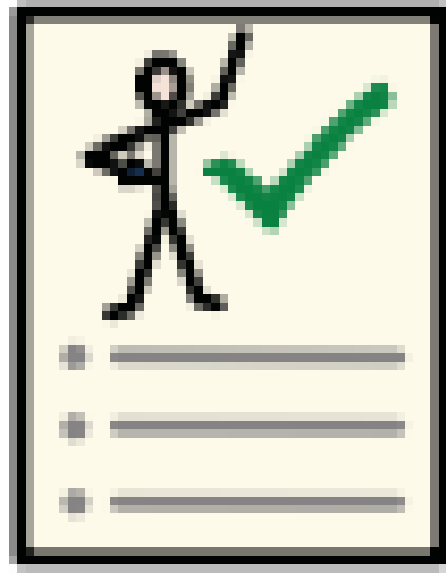

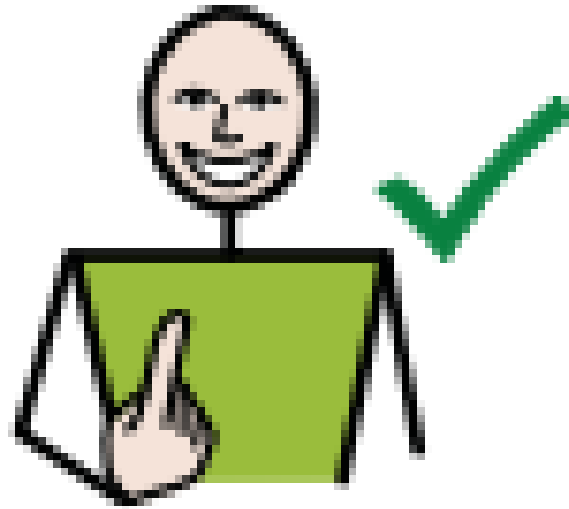
