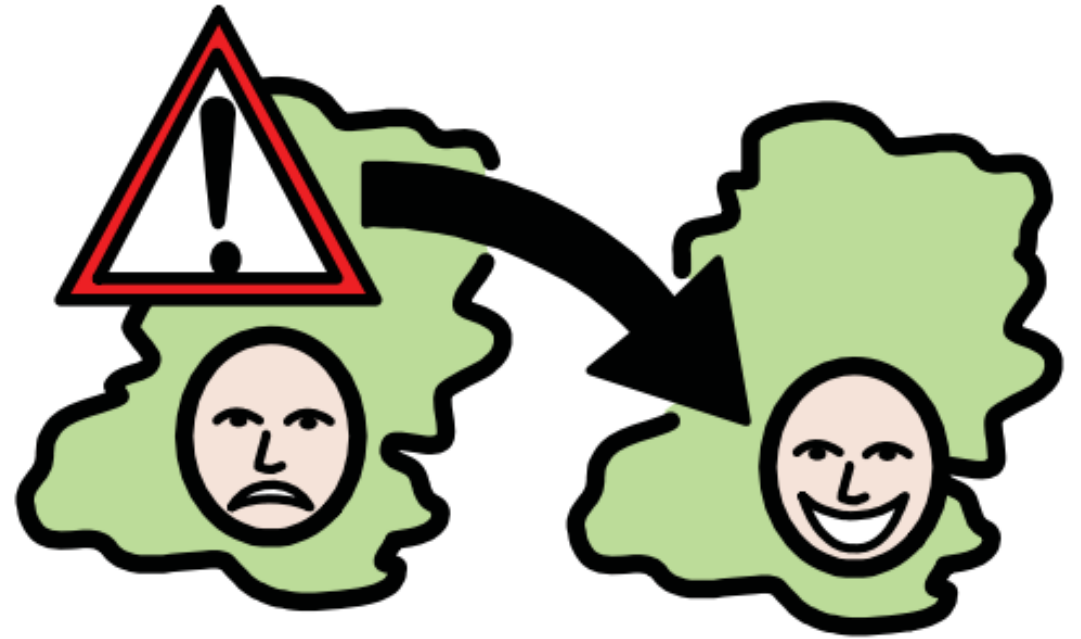
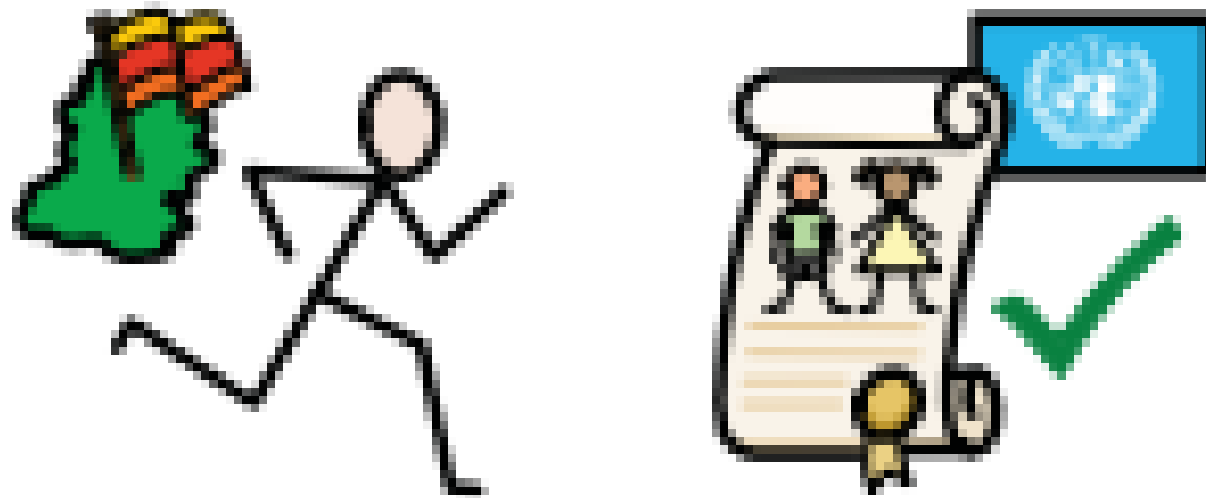

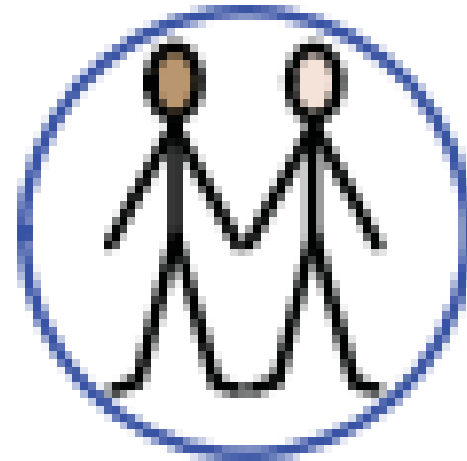
If I am a refugee,

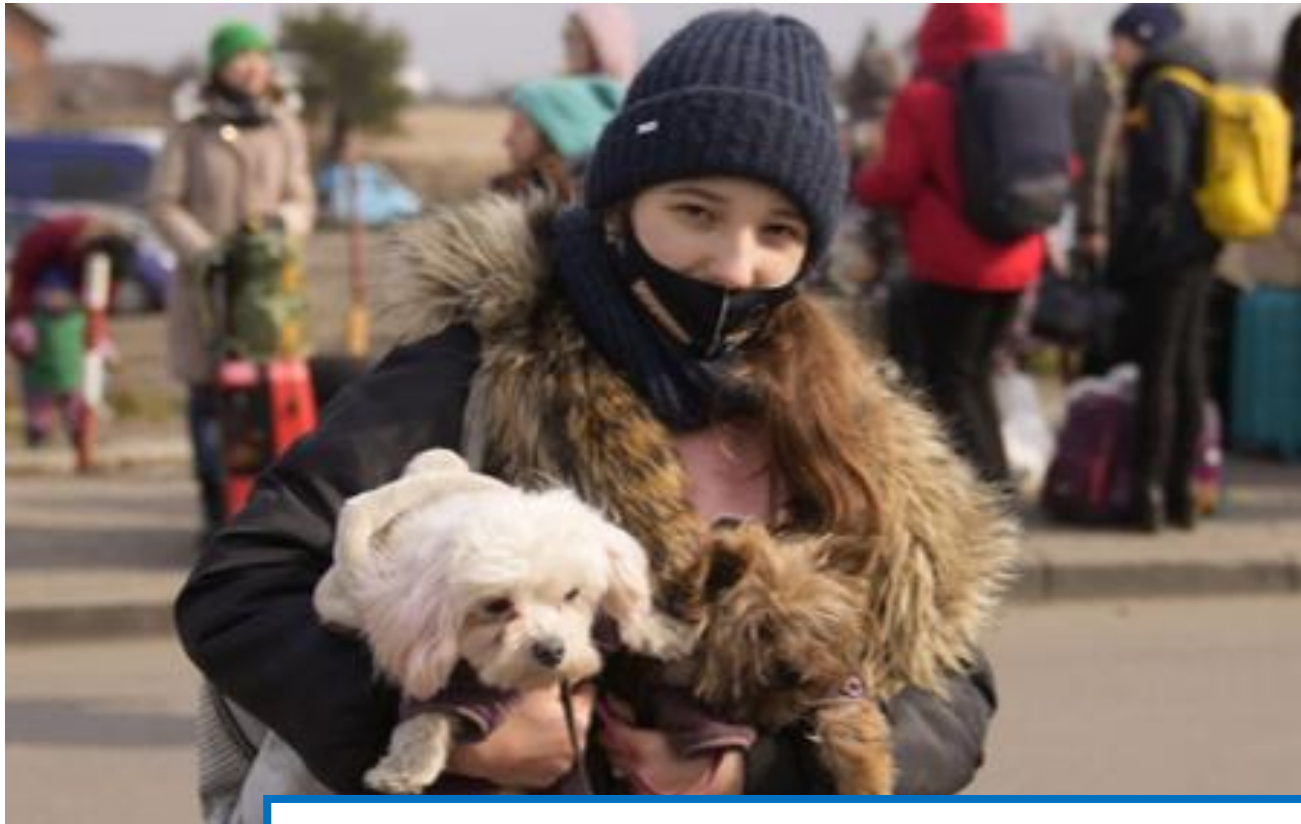
