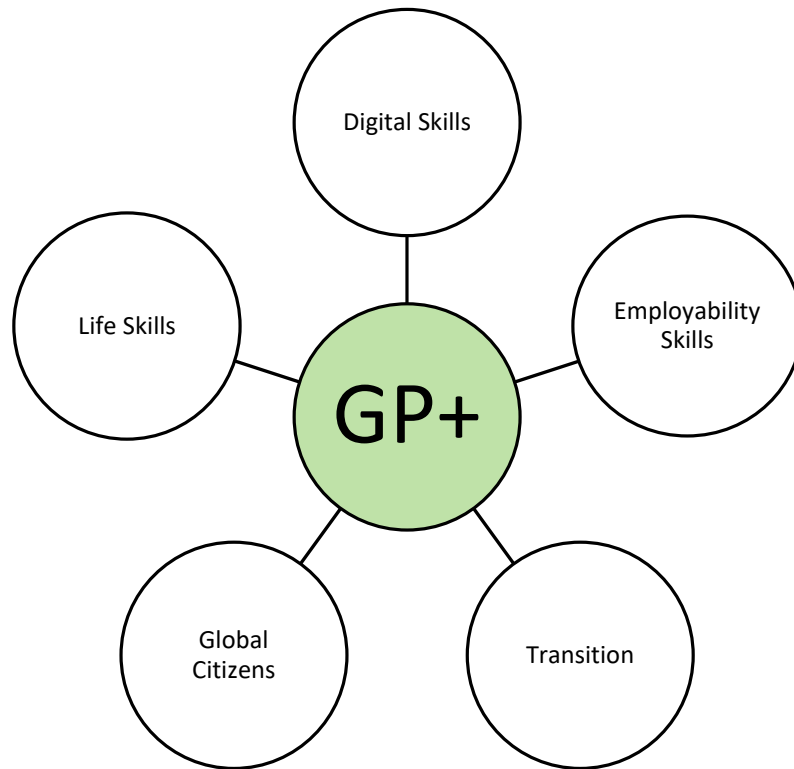


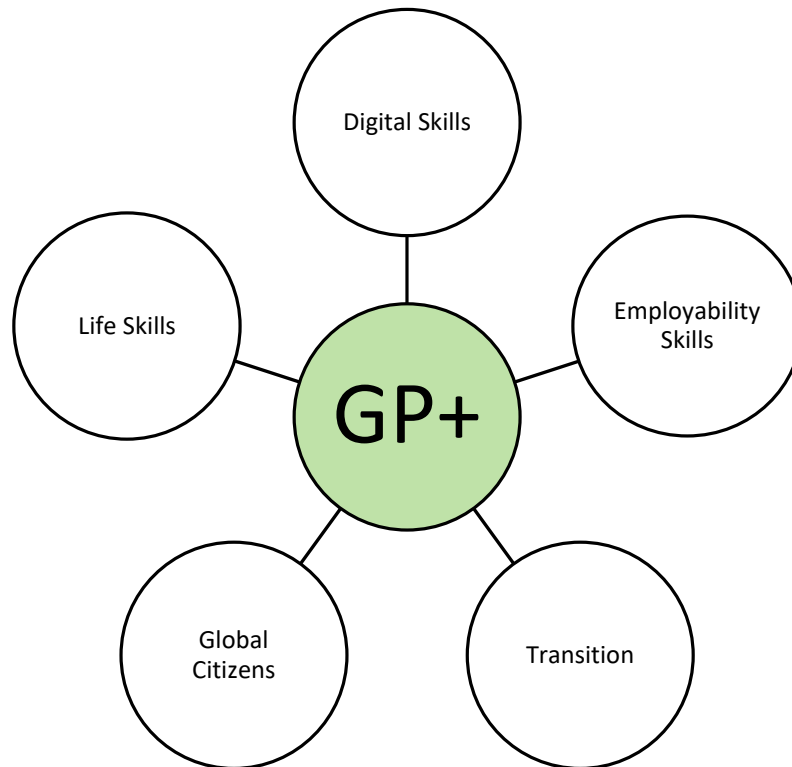

Each section of GP+ has criteria that the students need to show evidence for. This can be in many forms and will be assessed by a member of the Grange Park staff.

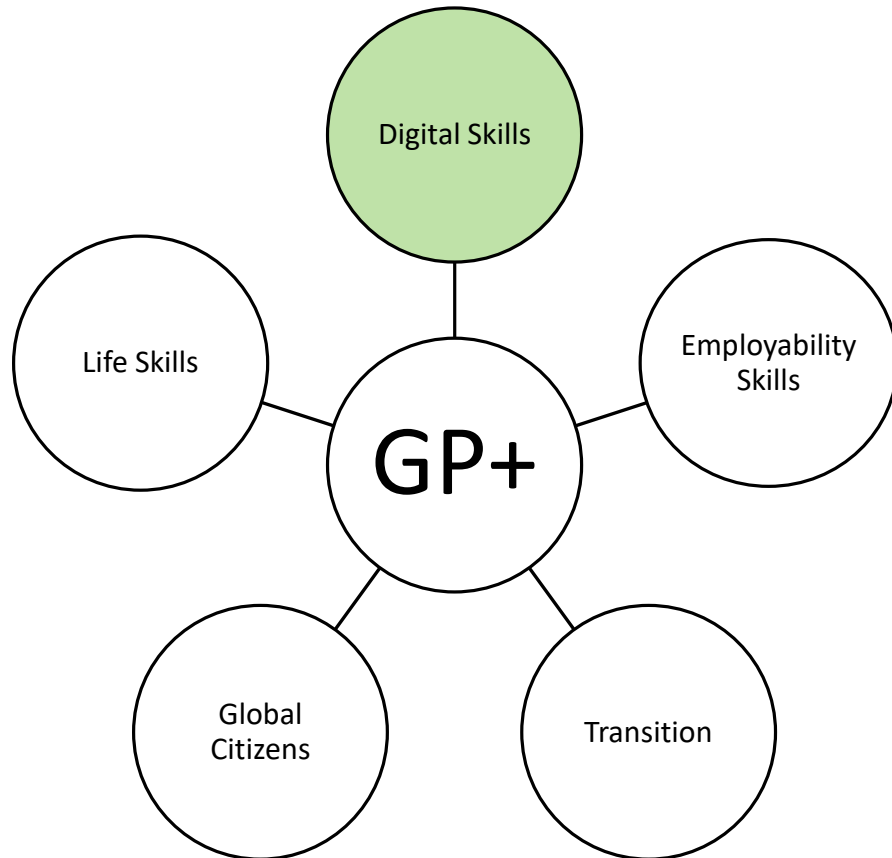
## Grange Park+ (January 2022 Pilot)
